The 2019 UK NOC Branch Secretaries' Meeting (BSM) is being held on Saturday 13April, commencing at 11.00am. The venue is the Canal & River Trust National Waterways Museum.

The 2019 National Rally takes place at St Audries Bay Holiday Club, Somerset between 27th and 29th September and will have a similar format to the Incider Rally which was held at Weston Super Mare last year. The Bristol branch of the NOC have agreed to help out with the organisation once again. Pricing for the event has not yet been finalised. The 2020 International Rally is provisionally planned to be in Portugal with the dates being either 22nd to 25th May or 19th to 22nd June. Details for this rally are at the planning stage.

Chrome Plating – A question had been asked at a recent meeting about recommendation's for a good quality local chrome plater. Andy has just had a few bits rechromed at Agbrigg Chrome Platers which is close to the White Rose shopping centre (Unit 8, Manor Mills, Leeds, LS11 8DB – Tel 07815 419885), these were 2 pushrods tubes, a rocker inspection plate, a gear lever and a kick start lever all for a 1955 ES2. The price for these 5 items was £100 and he was quoted 5 to 6 weeks turnaround time (they actually were ready in 3-days). The quality of the work looks good but obviously time will tell on the durability. The majority of the work in progress at Agbrigg seemed to be motorcycle related.

The first branch ride out of the year is scheduled for Saturday 20th April, for the season opener we will be taking in an area around the Yorkshire Dales. Meet at 10.00am for a 10.30am prompt start.
