



# Branch Meeting Minutes - 14th August 2019

## 1. Chairman (Russ Ward)

On Sunday the 4<sup>th</sup> the branch put on a display of 10 Norton's with the NOC marque again erected for the day, thankfully the rain forecast for the afternoon did not materialize and the event was blessed with good weather. Thanks go out to Dave Roberts, Geoff Drury and Tony Ward for delivering and collection of the marque and to Ross Ward for storing the marque after the event. Unfortunately, Dave Bell was unwell on the day of the show, so after all his hard work organising the event he was unable to attend. Peter Holland took the Navigator that he has recently restored to the show, the bike has been restored to a high standard but prior to the show the engine had not been run although it was ready to go apart from there being no petrol in the tank, after gentle encouragement from branch members a pop bottle full of fuel was drained from Martin's Commando tank and after suitable priming the bike started first kick after over 50 years inactivity and sounded very nice.
