Branch Meeting Minutes – 12th September 2023 Venue – The Marsh, Pudsey.

1. Chairman (Russ Ward)

Russ welcomed all 12 attendees and opened the meeting at 8.30pm.

2. Secretary (Andy Lodge)

Tony and Russ Ward attended the NOC International Rally in Sweden that occurred over the weekend of 12th and 13th August. They reported that the event was very well (fantastic was the word used) organised with good food and good weather, they also said that the area of Sweden was very sparsely populated and the large organised ride out saw very little traffic out on the route making it great for biking. 14 nations were represented at the rally.

The 2024 International rally will be held in Spain (Tossa de Mar) on the east coast above Barcelona on the 1st and 2nd June 2024. No further details have been released as yet.

3. Ride Outs 2023 (Andy Lodge)

Sunday 13th August – Peak District ride out.
