

Branch Meeting Minutes 11th March 2025 Venue – The Marsh, Pudsey.

1. Chairman (Russ Ward)

Russ welcomed all 17 attendees then opened the meeting at 8.30 pm.

2. Secretary (Andy Lodge)

Apologies for absence – Ian Bannister, Bruce Senior and Barry Crosby.
